

OTHER HAPPENINGS AT THE JACARANDA RALLY

Office Hours – the office will be open from 9.00am until 3.00pm, except on the Thursday when it will close at 1.00pm.

Sign In – first thing on arrival after parking. This covers you with the insurance. Collect your free race and dinner tickets plus your BBQ ticket if you have prepaid. You will also be given a site sticker to put onto your CMCA current membership card. Lanyards and plastic inserts will be available for a very small charge if you want them. These are to be worn when around the undercover area, so we can know if you belong to us, or are just someone who has wandered in off the street.

Tours, BBQ breakfasts - someone will be sitting near, but outside the office to take your money for any vacant tour seats, or for the breakfast.

Problems – if you have a problem, come and let us know. We will try and deal with it. If you don't let us know, we can't help you. We are there to make your stay a good one.

Arriving the Day Before – let me know and you can come in early, but you will be required to pay for the extra nights. We only collect the site fees for the two clubs.

Electrical Tagging – bring your cord along if you are on power and it doesn't have a current tag. Your cord will be tested for free, but if there is a defect you may have to pay the cost price only for the defected part. It only takes a minute or so if there are no problems.

Grey Water – may be let go slowly inside the fenced areas only.

Black Water – Call Barry – 0466449916, or Ted on 0429645224 to collect you and your cassette to take you to the dump point and return. Try and avoid meal times and late at night please.

Morning and Afternoon Teas – bring your own mugs to the undercover area and join us at 10.00 to 10.30am and again at 3.00 to 3.30pm from Sunday afternoon onwards. Cakes, slices and bikkies provide.

Raffles – there are two raffles during the week. The major raffle is about \$700.00 worth of prizes drawn on the Saturday night. Most afternoons tickets are sold for this raffle, and at that time there is a draw for meat trays, alcohol, vouchers etc. at the end of this draw, all tickets purchased that afternoon go into a big bag and all are eligible for the major draw on the Saturday, even if you won a prize in the afternoon draw.

The second raffle is in aid of the Westpac Helicopter Rescue Appeal. The prizes are a bottle of whiskey, a large bottle of Baileys and wine and beer. You choose your poison as your name is drawn out. This raffle is drawn on the Thursday afternoon.

When you buy your tickets, you need to give your site number, not your name. It is much faster for us to write a number than a name.

Happy Hour - bring your own drinks and nibbles and share some friendship time with others at the rally.

Town Buses – each day, from Monday, the first bus will depart at 8.30am for the three shopping precincts in the CBD. The buses will then depart on the hour with the last pick up bus leaving at 2.00pm. These buses are free. They will go to the Jockey Club to pick up if there are vacant seats and return you to the Jockey Club also.

Internal Buses – a bus will do pick ups at the Jockey club area from 2.45pm each day. The number and times of the trips will be on a daily schedule but will run regularly until about 5.00pm each day. The bus will then begin about 15 minutes before the scheduled night entertainment and will return you at the end of the night's entertainment.

BBQ in Undercover Area – you may use this, but not on Tuesday evening, to cook your dinner. You need to bring your own utensils as well as your food. The BBQ plate must be left clean after use.

Washing up in Undercover Area – sorry, but because of the nonexistence of plumbing from the sink, you will need to take your dirty plates etc back to your van to clean. The bucket below must be emptied continually, and this can be heavy work for some of our older workers.

Board Games/ Jigsaws – these are on a table near the fridges. Please use when you wish and return them back after use for others. The jigsaw has a board on which you can assemble the jigsaw. This may stay out but make certain it is not in a draughty place or the loose pieces will be all over the place. We need to put it in the office when the undercover area is needed.

Pub Lunches – on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Saturday a bus will transport you to a pub from about 11.30am. the last bus will return from the pub at 2.00pm. on the Wednesday, the club is the South Ex-servicemen's club. On this day you may take the CBD bus at 11.00am and have a look at the Woodworking and Embroidery Exhibitions on the first floor. Likewise, you can wander upstairs after your meal, but be ready for the last bus when it gets there.

Jams, pickles, chutneys, sauces and books - Yvonne has these on sale each day, with an honesty box for your money. All money goes to the Westpac Helicopter Appeal. Yvonne's last cheque to this appeal was \$1,000.

Booking Sheets – pub lunches, GDSC (Friday night), disc bowls, finska, craft and uke sessions etc -when you arrive, put your name down for any activity etc, that you wish to attend.
